



## PRE-K2 PROGRAM

### POTTY TRAINING

In the Pre-K2 class toilet training is part of the curriculum. In the Toilet Training Program teachers guide and assist the students with this milestone. Proven toilet training techniques are used to promote a positive and supportive environment.

### LANGUAGE ARTS

Our inquisitive Pre-K2 students start developing fine and gross motor skills by introducing cutting skills and tracing objects aiding the students in becoming more successful writers. The students will learn to recognize and name objects and identify letters associated with those objects. Blending sounds from pictures and the collection and investigation of evidence enhance the learning experience. Using location words and categorizing like pictures teaches our children to reference and sort.

### MATHEMATICS

Learning to distinguish between numbers and count to at least 10, our Pre-K2 students have fun with math through basic shapes and the concept of size using the latest methods to build a strong foundation.

### SOCIAL STUDIES

Our Pre-K2 students are introduced to the essentials of local geography distinguishing between here and there. Students learn to appreciate other cultures through festive celebrations. Meeting our first responders allow students to recognize the men and women who support us in our most critical moments.

### SCIENCE

Our Pre-K2 class learns the basics of agriculture by observing plant growth. Students explore the principles of biology, the environment, and earth science. Students learn about the sun, moon and earth introducing them to space.

### TECHNOLOGY & ENGINEERING

Technology is introduced by identifying technological items at a basic level. Learning to think, create, and share for 2 year old's are the corner stones of Engineering. Showing friends their latest creation instills one of the three pillars of engineering.

### FINE ARTS

The Pre-K2 class enjoys an interactive approach to the fine arts. The introduction to different types of music help promote their creation of different forms of dance movements. Theatrics are encouraged through animal imitation and sing along. While abstract art in the form of your child's finger paintings reinforce color recognition.

### FOREIGN LANGUAGE
