

PRE-K3 PROGRAM

LANGUAGE ARTS

Building on Pre-K2 skills, the investigative Pre-K3 students learn to work with letter distinction and tracing those letters as well as rhyming through nursery themes. Book knowledge is introduced with students identifying the title and spine of a book along with learning the difference of an author and illustrator. Color and number words are introduced and used in basic sentence structure to help our students articulate their thoughts. We also teach object isolation to emphasize distinction among objects.

MATHEMATICS

Our Pre-K3 students study the comparison of shapes and size. They will learn to count to at least 20 and identify patterns. We encourage the beginning of complex thought at this level. Students begin to learn the concept of taking a 2D drawing to a 3D object.

SOCIAL STUDIES

Our Pre-K3 students examine the difference between oceans and continents. Exploring the concept of topography reinforces the elevations of mountains and valleys. Economics begins with Financial Literacy in understanding currency, e.g., identification of coins and dollar bills. Our students learn the location of each state on the map and the history behind our United States flag, e.g., the stars represent states. Also, the significance of historical figures and the impact they had on our country.

SCIENCE

Our Pre-K3 students gain an understanding of how living things depend on the environment around them. Our students learn that the difference between the four seasons affects all living things. We focus on our solar system and identifying the planets. We also explore the world around us through the five senses.

TECHNOLOGY & ENGINEERING

Our Pre-K3 students are introduced to the parts of a computer and learn how other technology is used to improve learning. Engineering is advancing from the Pre-K2 class focusing on the components required to create stable structures.

FINE ARTS

Architecture is introduced by identifying the different types of buildings, e.g., skyscrapers and homes. Pre-K3 students are taught the theory of music, e.g., rhythm, melody, and pitch. Art in this class begins by understanding the different types of drawings and paintings. Our Pre-K3 students are taught how to interpret these areas of the fine arts.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

In addition to reiterating numbers and colors, our Pre-K3 students will begin to learn the Spanish ABC's and greetings.

HEALTH & FITNESS

In the Pre-K3 class the students attain knowledge of the inner workings of the human body. Motor skills are emphasized with fun engaging activities within our fitness program.
